## COURSE INFORMATION:

For adult courses, both dinghy and yacht, the meeting area is at the rear of the club, next to the boats on the hard area.

To bring: ***Suncream is a must for all***

Yachts:

- Casual clothing suitable for the day, with a change of clothes in case you get wet
- Soft soled, non marking shoes. Joggers are fine, but check the soles and make sure they are not worn smooth. If you are thinking of purchasing shoes – Dunlop white volleys are a good cheap shoe.
- Gloves are recommended, but not necessary for beginner level.
- Please make sure that you have a good hat that is not going to blow off or in your face, and sunglasses.
- A spray jacket or wet-weather gear is recommended.
- Please also bring some water or drink.

Dinghys: PFD's (lifejacket) provided.

- Preferably a wetsuit, but boardshorts & rash vest is fine as long as it is not going to get cold.
- Shoes that can get wet. Wetsuit boots are ideal as they will allow you to hike out without any injury to your ankles – feel free to speak to us about this.
- Hat is mandatory. Sunglasses recommended.
- Gloves are highly recommended for dinghy sailing – you'll know after the first lesson!
- Bottled water

## RISK WARNING

This risk warning is issued by Gosford Sailing Club, pursuant to the Civil Liability Act 2002 to all persons wishing to participate in the sailing activities conducted by Gosford Sailing Club.

Participants are warned that, regardless of the precautions, which might be taken by reasonable & experienced persons, sailing can be a dangerous pursuit & participants are exposed to significant risks of property damage, physical harm & possibly death.

As an indication, these risks may include, but are not limited to:

The extremes of weather & sea conditions

The potential that control of vessels might be lost, resulting in collisions with objects & other vessels

The sudden movement of the vessel at any time & the possibility that participants may fall or be thrown overboard, resulting in drowning

The possibility that participants may be injured by equipment on the vessel

The absence of immediate medical care & the likelihood that significant delays may occur Before medical care is available

Exposure to the elements for extended periods

Gosford Sailing Club also warns participants that regardless of their it's best intentions, the club may be unable to render assistance to participants who are in distress. Participants are warned to consider the above risks & all other risks before deciding to participate in any sailing event with Gosford Sailing Club.

Participants are also advised that although Gosford Sailing Club is covered by third party liability insurance, this cover DOES NOT extend to participants for personal accidents.

Any participant who considers they have a need for insurance must make their own private arrangements with an insurer. A personal accident insurance policy is available with subscription to membership of Yachting NSW.
